^{*}Please note that if you choose one of our payment plans, a financing fee will be applied, which will result in the total tuition being higher than the one-time payment tuition price. The financing fee is designed to cover the administrative costs associated with the installment plan.

Multiple-Student Discount: Families with tuition-paying students qualify for a discount based on the total number of tuition paying students: \$175 for two students, \$350 for three students, \$700 for four students, and \$1,400 for five students. The discount is applied per family, not per student. Families receiving tuition assistance may choose either the assistance or this discount, whichever is greater, as discounts are not combined.

FACTS BILLING & PAYMENT PLANS

Faith Christian School utilizes FACTS for all billing. This allows for reviewing and paying securely on-line, setting up automatic billing.

We Offer Three Payment Plan Options:

- 1. One-time payment: paid in full by July 3, 2025
- 2. <u>Bi-annual payments:</u> first payment due by July 3, 2025 and the second payment due by December 5, 2025
- 3. <u>11 monthly payments:</u> These are scheduled electronic payments either on the 5th or 20th of each month, beginning in July 2025.

Dates based on enrollment prior to June 20, 2025. A 1% late fee will be assessed on all balances over 30 days. The Board of Directors reserves the right to withdraw a student(s) if a family is unable to fulfill their financial obligation in a timely manner.

POLICIES

High School Graduation Policy: A student who has completed all graduation requirements, but whose tuition and/or fees are delinquent, will be permitted to walk at the graduation ceremony, but will not receive their diploma or transcripts until their account is paid in full.

Early Withdrawal/Dismissal Policy: Parents wishing to withdraw their child from FCS should promptly contact the Admissions Director and complete and submit the withdrawal form to the Head of School. Withdrawal is allowed at any time for any reason, but tuition is still owed for the enrolled quarters. FCS will provide details on financial terms. The school reserves the right to decide on enrollment. In unforeseen withdrawal circumstances, families can appeal outstanding balances to the Board of Directors.

WISCONSIN PARENTAL CHOICE PROGRAM (WPCP)

The Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP) allows many families to be eligible for a tuition at no cost. Listed below are the 2025-26 income limits for the WPCP, you can also visit the WPCP website. The application period for the 25-26 school year will be open on February 3 and closes on April 17, 2025.

A family must be at or below these income levels to qualify for a WPCP tuition voucher. This is based on your 2024 Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) found on page 1 of your Federal Tax Return.

TUITION ASSISTANCE

Families who do not qualify for WPCP and still have a financial need may apply for tuition assistance after the admissions application process and been enrolled.

- Tuition Assistance is known as the Grant & Aid/ Financial Aid in the FACTS system; a third-party company.
- There is no application fee
- Pre-K students are not eligible
- Re-enrolling families must submit their application by March 6, 2025.
